PAPER TWIST HEART WITH BIBLE PASSAGE (1-2 days' work)

Materials for each heart: (finished heart size: 6" high x4 1/2")


2 -18" lengths of untwisted paper twist (in complementary colors)

1 yd. matching 1/8" wide satin ribbon

10" length of 26 guage craft wire

Passage (Jn. 11:25-26) with a hole punched in end (pattern below) Scissors

Glue gun (adults may wish to handle the glue gun after class) Magnetic tape if you want this to be a magnet (optional)



Directions:

Holding ends even, twist the two lenghts of paper twist together. (Do not untwist the paper twist) When they are twisted together to form one rope, bring ends together folding the rope in half.

Crease fold - this will be the point of the heart. With craft wire, tie ropes together 1" from the cut ends. Trim ends evenly. Curve the ends down between the ropes, and shape and adjust to form a heart shape.

To make hanger, cut a 5" length of ribbon. Fold, forming a loop. With glue gun, glue ribbon ends to wire at the back of the heart.


To make a bow with several loops on each side, first reserve a 7" length of ribbon. Then make loops by wrapping remaining ribbon around three fingers. Tie the center of the loops with the reserved piece. Glue the bow to cover wire at front of heart. Glue or tie passage to a loop end. Evenly trim ribbon tails diagonally.

If you wish to make this a magnet, stick a 1" strip of magnetic tape to back of heart. You will not need the hanging loop.





Trace and cut out cross from posterboard or stiff paper. Copy Bible passage to back of cross. They may inclue their name and year.

Trace and cut out material cross. Glue to top of paper cross. Allow to dry and apply contact paper to both sides if desired. Punch hole at top of cross. Thread cord or ribbon and knot to make tassel

Spreading glue on a small area at a time, arrange beads, beans, or whatever is used to cover the cross on the glued area. Spray paint with gold or silver when dried. (optional) Hang using cord or

PASSOVER & CROSS SCENE

Materials:

3 popsicle sticks

1 1/2 plain white (uncoated) paper plates passage (see below)

4 1/2x2" brown construction paper rectangle watercolors (must have red) & paintbrush glue


yarn hole punch

zig zag or trim (optional)

Directions:

Using watercolors (tempera will work), paint the front of the whole paper plate in a pleasing design. Paint the back side of the half plate in a contrasting color. Glue the two plates together as shown below (diagram 1) making sure the painted sides are showing. (Note: half of the whole paper plate will be covered)

Glue the brown construction paper to the bottom plate as shown (diagram 2). Cut one popsicle stick in half and add the sticks to both sides as the doorpost and cross as shown (diagram 3). Paint red on doorpost and 3 places on cross (diagram 4). Using the hole punch, punch holes evenly spaced around the edge and weave the yarn making a hanger on the top. (diagram 4) Glue the passage below the cross and add trim to the cut and outer edges if desired.


CROSSES WITH BRASS DOORKNOB HANGER





Directions:

Fold white construction paper into 3 parts - 8", A", 8" (see above). Cut out all figures. Make slits in fish and tomb. Insert pull tabs as shown in diagram 2. Glue Jonah and stone to end of pull tabs as shown (see diagram 1). Glue fish and Jonah to right 7" side. (Be sure not to glue the pull tab on the back side.) Glue tomb and stone to left 7" side. Glue passage to center 2". Using crayons or markers add scenery to both sides.






