Rainbow fan-fold Story Book all levels

Tools needed: Glue sticks, scissor

Wide clear packing tape

Markers, red/yellow paint

brown / green fabric paint

Crystal glitter, gold glitter, small gems

Supplies: per child



Construction paper strips 3 strips each color

Graphics / passage pages

2-36" ribbon (1/4"wide)



Pages: 1/2 cardstock and 3 strips construction paper

—the colors are both red but the cardstock red should be brighter or deeper red than construction paper Glue strips diagonally across the cardstock for all 6 colors (strips should be approx. 1/2")

Cut out and arrange the graphics and passage = 1 page per day of learning

\*\*suggestions = have younger students color the graphics in class and glue in their book daily take class pictures on Monday for book on Friday

Monday :start the book—complete each page of book—cardstock and strips

Start with cover and Monday story graphics—do as many days tues-wed-thurs story graphics as have time

Tuesday – Wednesday — Thursday there are other craft suggestions


Friday: finish the book—Finish gluing story grpahics to book pages




Paper for tables and paper plates for paint

# **Instructions: Sand art cross**

- 1. Cut out cardtock pattern box
- 2. Decorate the handles and sides using sponges and paint
- 3. Glue a graphic on each of the larger front and back panels of box
- 4. Fold along the dotted lines









# Day 3 Craft— Sand art Cross

#### Tools needed craft for both levels:

Sponge makeup applicators (to apply glue fingers work also)

Scissors for upper grade level

Paper for catching excess sand -

using paper to also sprinkle the sand onto the glued area works well to channel sand where needed—upper level

# **Before class Prep work**

### Materials for craft for Sand cross

Sand art cross cutouts—1 large and 1 small white cardstock

Borwn and black sand –can mix with clear glitter for a sparkle effect

Outer brown construction paper cross

3D dots

Ribbon for use as hanger


#### **Instructions: Sand art cross**

- 1. Use card stock cross to trace outside on brown construction paper then cut out the white area of the Cardstock cross
- 2. Cut Small center cardstock cross (small black(red) cross)
  - mix black and brown sand together for a texture look
  - •• apply glue to the cross and sprinkle with sand mixture
- 3. Loop a ribbon piece and tape to the brown construction paper cross to use as hanger tape in an area where the white cross will be glued—this will strengthen the hanger
- 4. Glue the sand cross to the center of the white cross
- 5. Place 3D dots on the brown cross first then position the white cross into center









# Day 4 Craft — Crown of life

#### Tools needed craft for both levels

Craft Glue or elmers regular glue

Scissors for upper grade level

Can also cut a paper crown out of paper plates for the younger students (see instruction pg)

# **Before class Prep work**

# Materials for craft for eternal crown plaque Cardstock patterns:

Square—4 Trianglar pieces—crown Green marble shelf paper - or -

You can use metallic green paper

Wood grained shelf paper - or -

you can use black cardstock

Gold foil or tissue paper

3D Dots (scrapbook section)

Sequins and jewls

Sturdy tape and paper clip

#### Instructions: Eternal Crown wall plaque

- 1. Cut out and cover the square with wood grained shelf paper cover top first and tape paper clip to back side before covering the back side
- 2. Cut out and cover all triangular shapes with green paper
- 3. Using the 3-D dots in each corner, place the triangles onto the wood grained square
- 4. Decorate the crown: glue crown to golden paper and cut out then decorate the crown with the sequins or jewels
- 5. Using 3-D Dots on each side of crown, place crown in center of the plaque.
