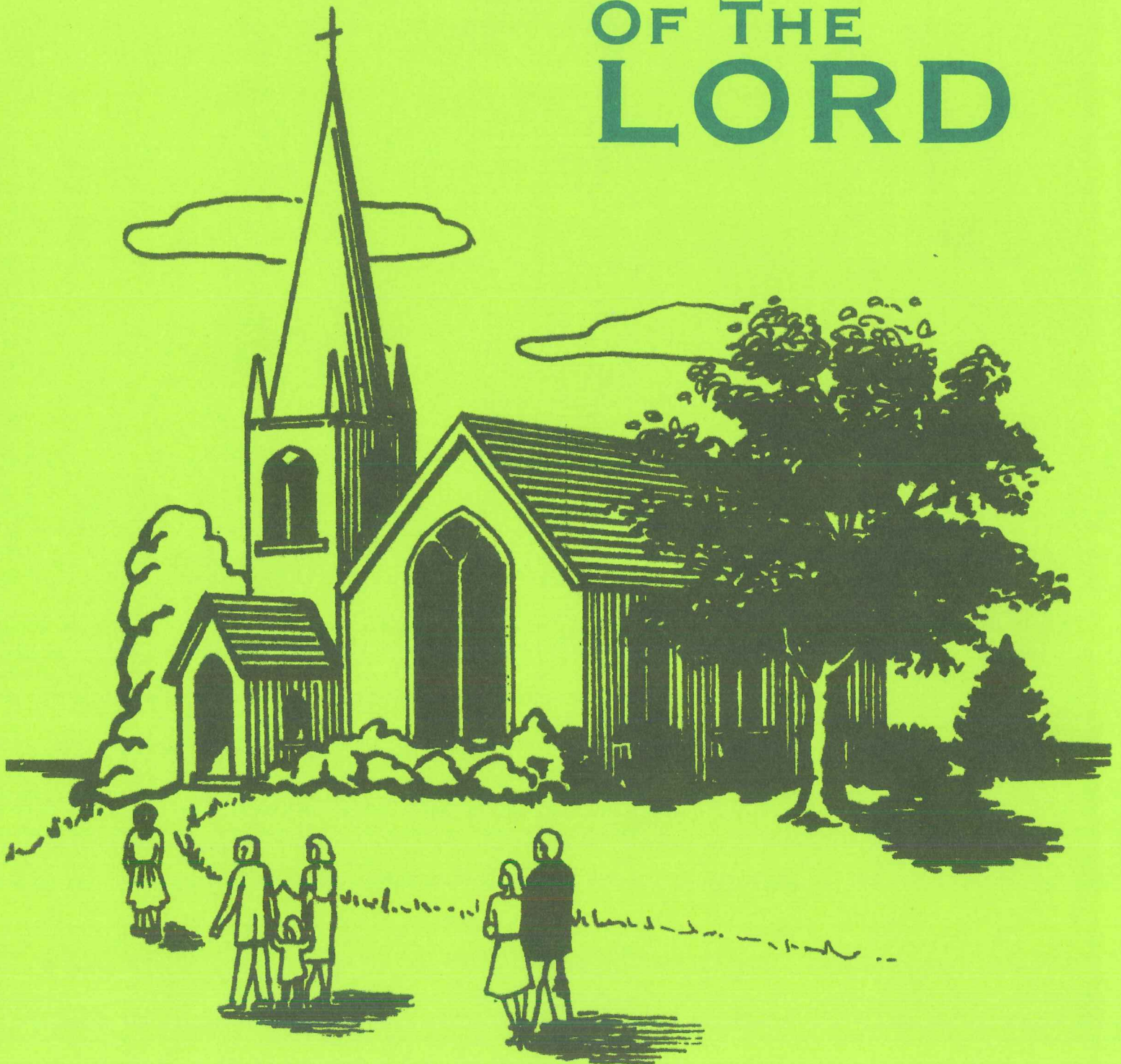

Lesson 1

Text: Acts 4:32-35, 5:1-11

WHAT IS CHURCH?

What are the courts of the LORD? Another word for court is church. Today we have a Bible story that tells us what church is.

There was a man named Ananias. His wife's name was Sapphira. They were members of the church at Jerusalem. They sold a piece of land. They kept part of the money for themselves and gave part of it to the church. They wanted everyone to think that they had given all the money to the church. They tried to fool God and the people. God told Peter what they had really done.

Ananias went to church one day. Peter said to Ananias, "Why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? You have not lied to men but to God." Then Ananias fell down and died. Some of the people buried him.

Later, his wife came into the church. Sapphira also lied. Peter said to her, "Why did you and your husband try to fool God? Those who have buried your husband are here. They will bury you, too." Right away she fell down and died. They buried her by her husband.

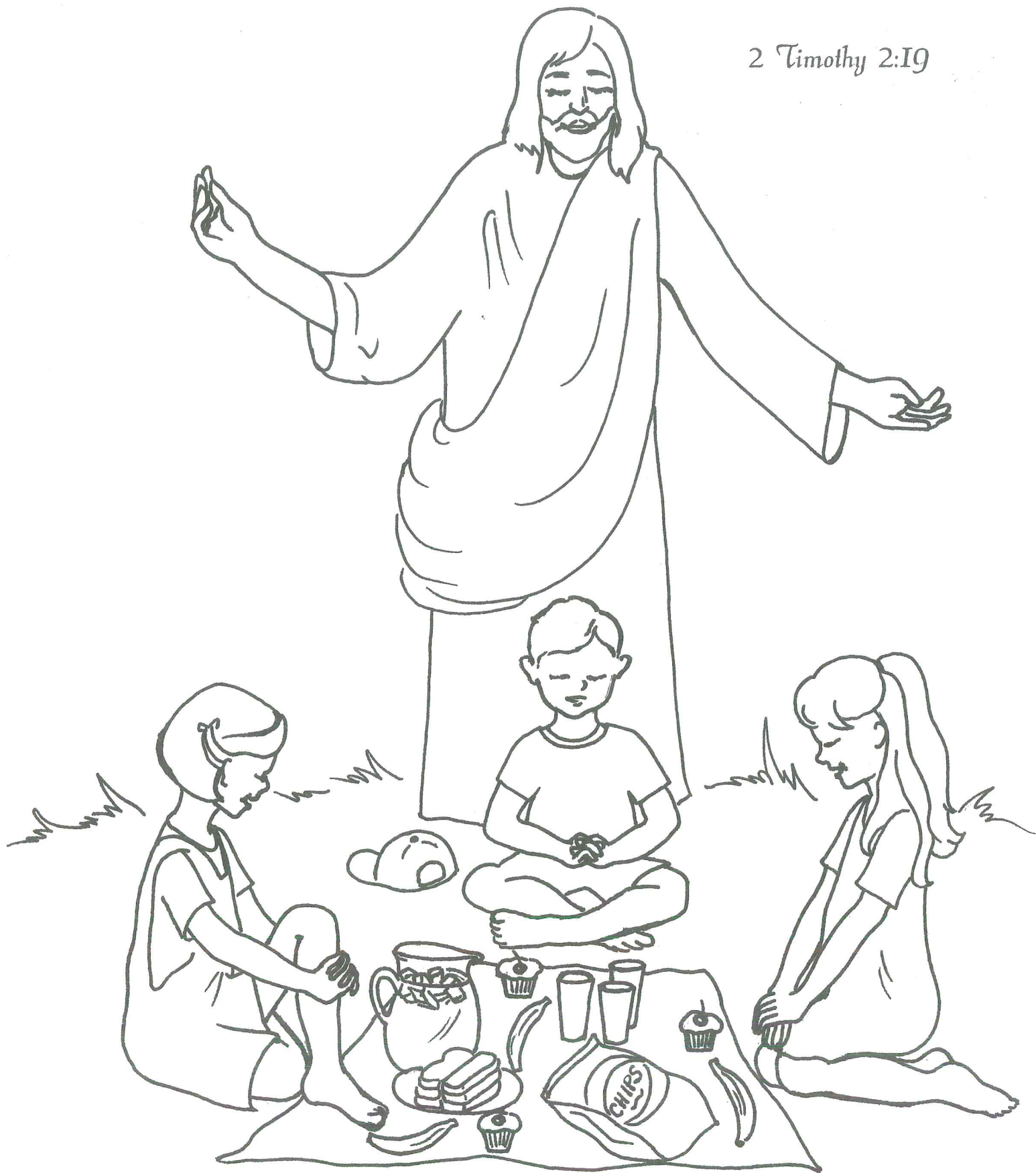

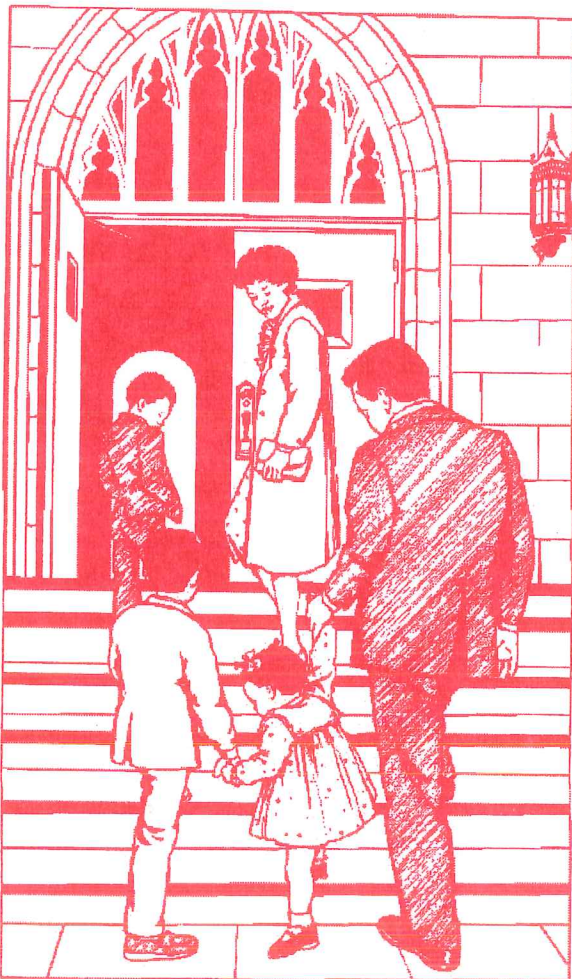
Lesson 2

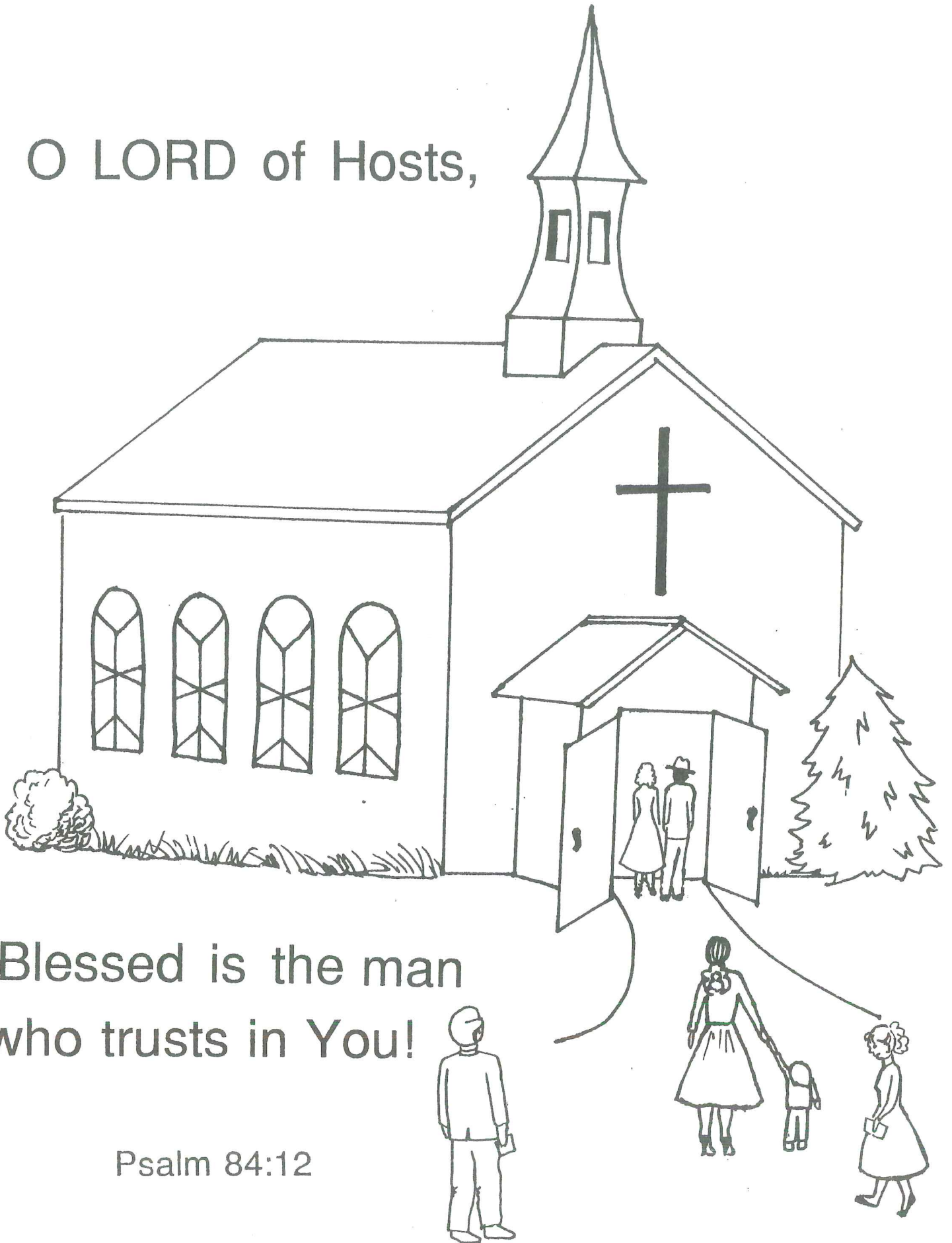

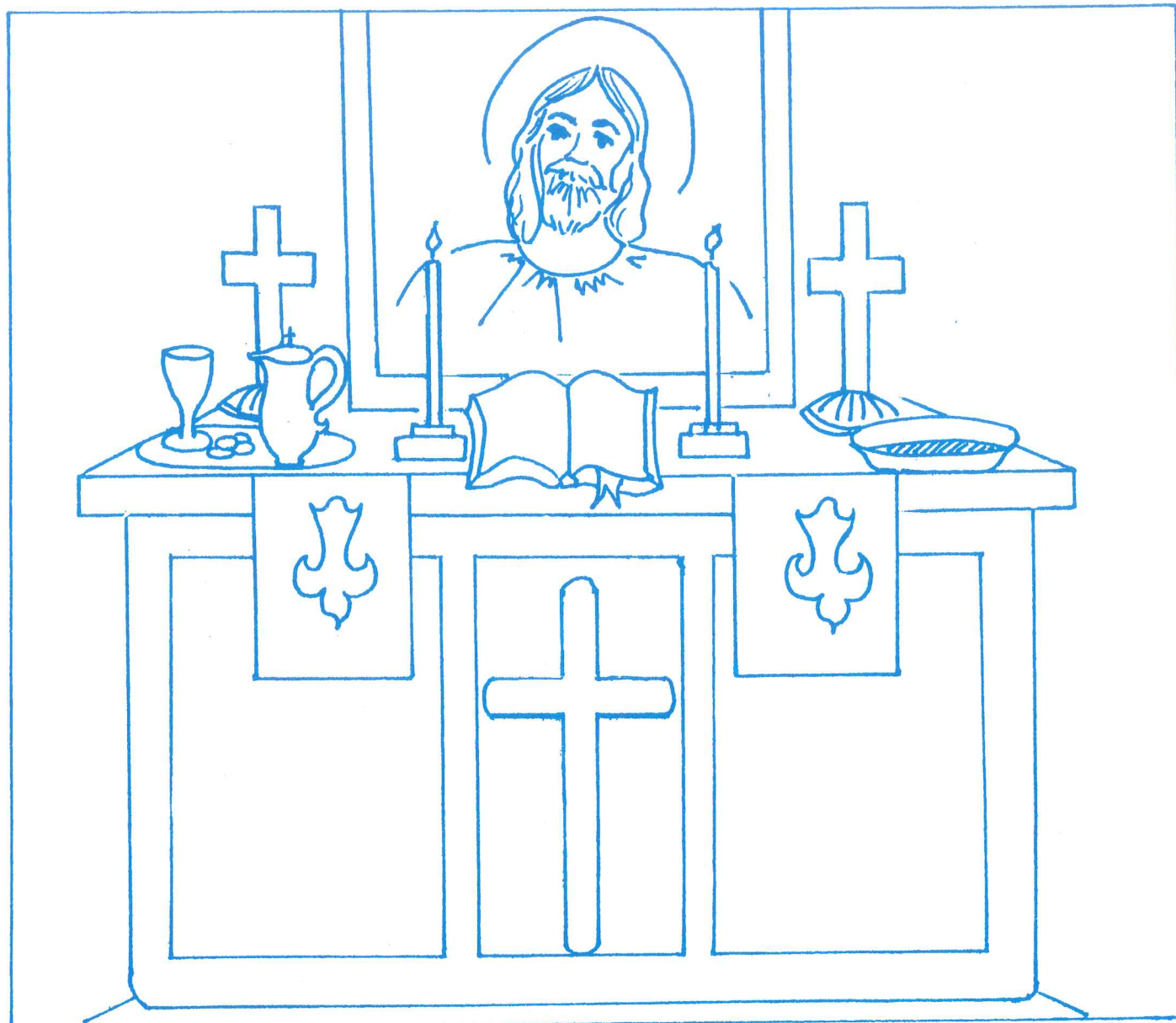

Text: John 4:5-26

WHAT HAPPENS IN CHURCH?

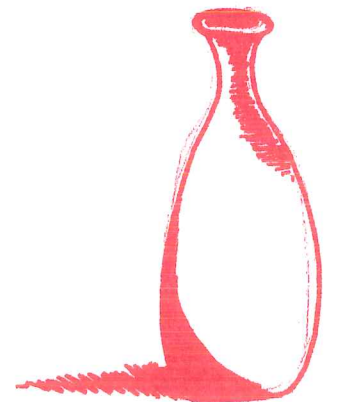
A church is a gathering of believers. We go to church because it is the home of our God. Today we will hear what happens in church.

One day Jesus was in Samaria. He stopped at a well. A woman came to the well to get some water. Jesus told her He had some Living Water. This water would make people live forever. Jesus was talking about Himself.

She wanted to know more about Jesus, so she asked Him a question. "Where is the best place to worship God?" Jesus said, "It doesn't matter where you worship God but you must believe in the True God and love Him."

She was sorry for her sins and believed in Jesus as her Savior. She told her family and many others about Jesus.

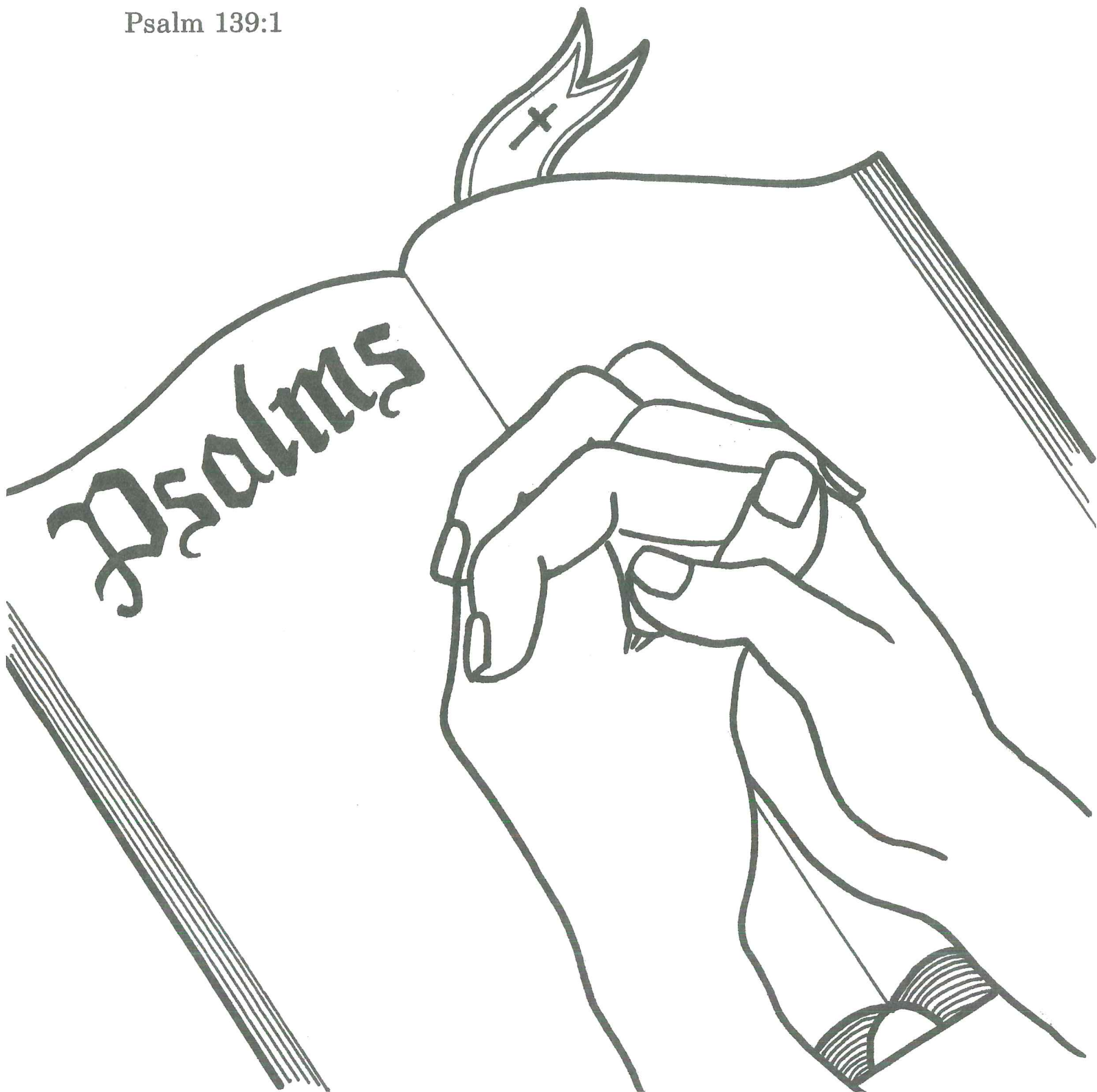
In the Bible we learn about God and what He wants us to believe. On Sundays, we go to church with Dad and Mom to study the Bible. We hear Bible stories and the minister tells us about Jesus. We tell God we are sorry for our sins. He tells us that He loves us and that He will save us. We hear how Jesus died to pay for our sins. We thank God for everything He has done for us. 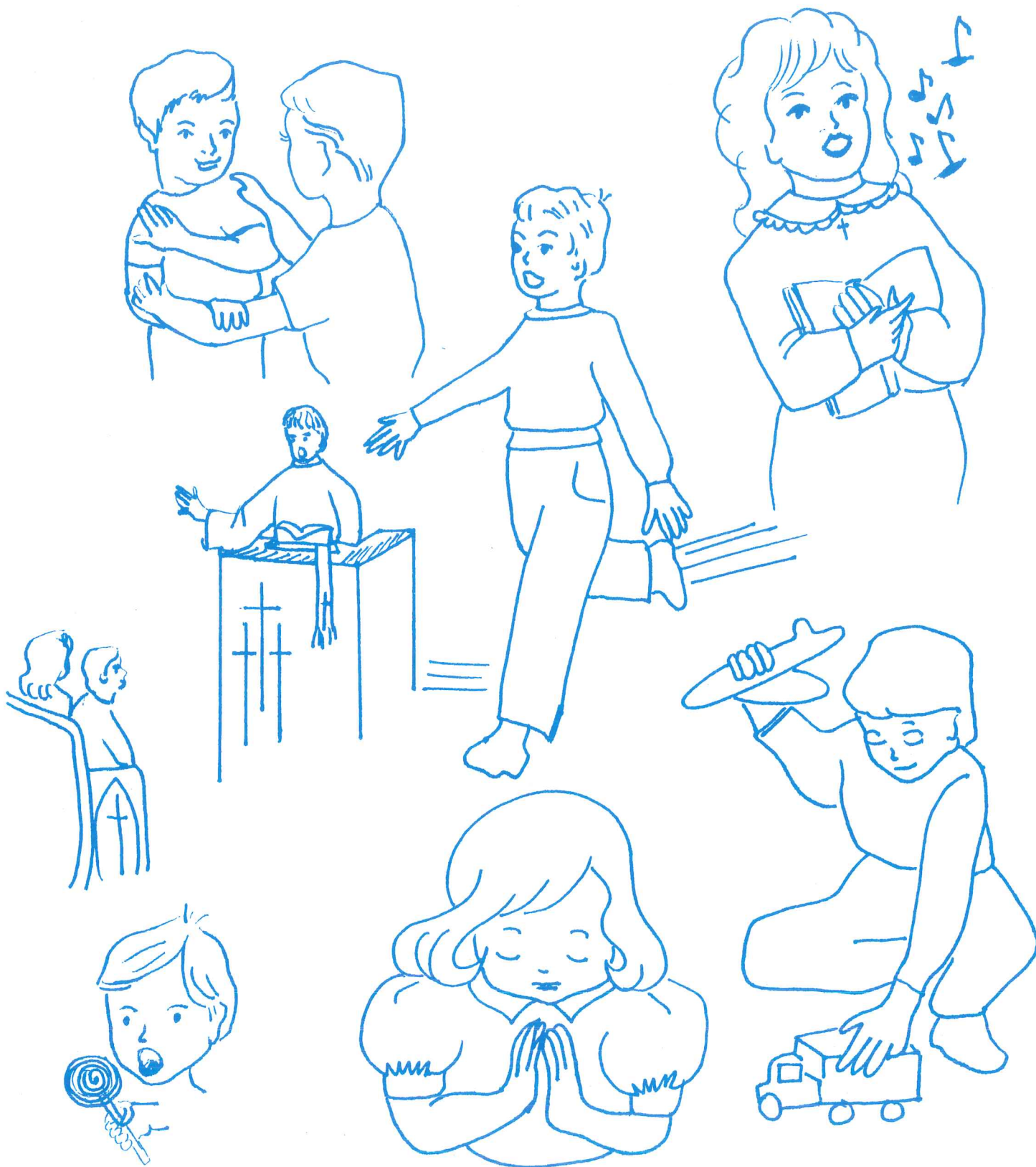

Text: Matthew 25:14-30

WHAT CAN WE DO FOR CHURCH?

Church is a gathering of Christians. We go to church because it is the home of our Father. In church God talks to us from the Bible and we sing and pray to Him. Today we will see what we can do for the Church of our God.

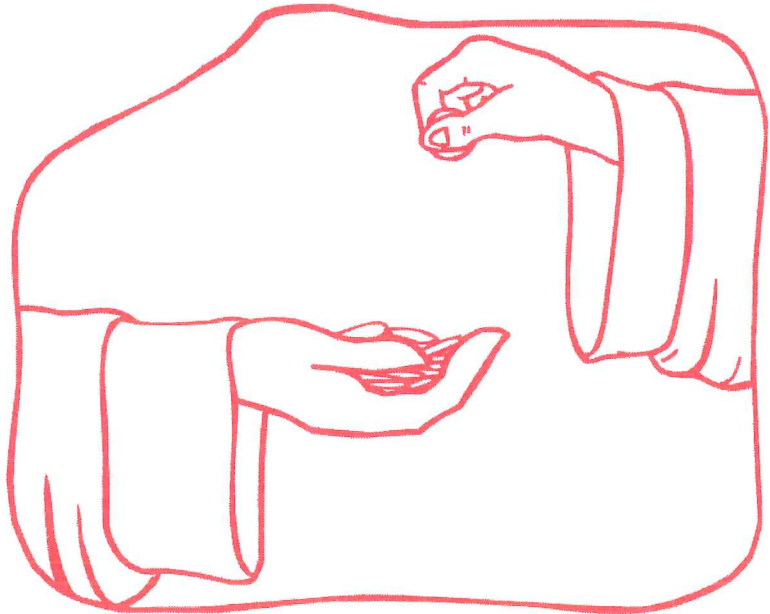
Jesus told this story:

A man was going on a trip. He asked his servants to take care of his money. He gave 5 pieces of money to one servant; 2 pieces to another servant; and one piece to a third servant.

After a long time the master returned and asked for his money. The servant with 5 pieces worked hard. He brought 5 more pieces and gave 10 pieces to the master. The master was happy. He said, "You are a good servant, I will give you a reward."

The servant with 2 pieces had worked hard. He brought 2 more pieces and gave 4 pieces to the master. The master was happy and said, "You are a good servant, I will give you a reward."

The servant with 1 piece was lazy. He had buried it in the ground. He brought only 1 piece of money to the master. The master was angry. He said, "You are not a good servant. I will not give you a reward. You are to be sent to hell."



Jesus told us this story to teach us that He gives gifts to each of us. He does not want us to be lazy and not use our gifts. He wants us to work hard. We are to use our gifts in His Church. He has told us the story about Jesus. We, too, are to tell others about Jesus.

Text: Haggai 2:1-9

HOW DO WE PICK A CHURCH?

Church is a gathering of believers. We go to church because it is the home of our God. In church God talks to us. We sing and pray to Him. Each of us is to use his gift from Jesus in the church. How do we know which church to go to? God tells us this story.

Our story takes place many years before the birth of Jesus. God's children had a big church in Jerusalem. It looked very beautiful. The people had worked hard to build it. They used a lot of gold and silver in the church.

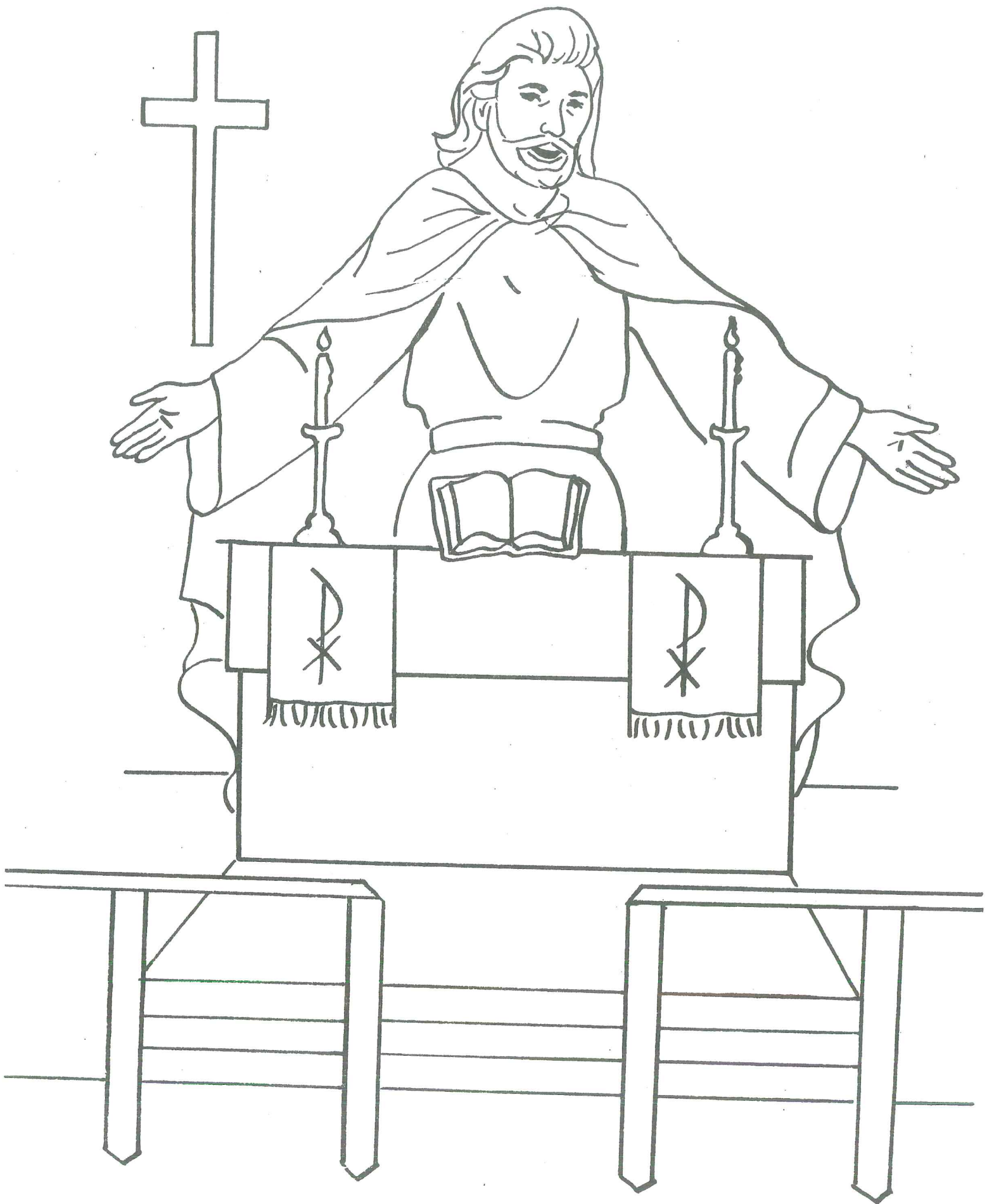

Without Jesus a church can only look beautiful on the outside.

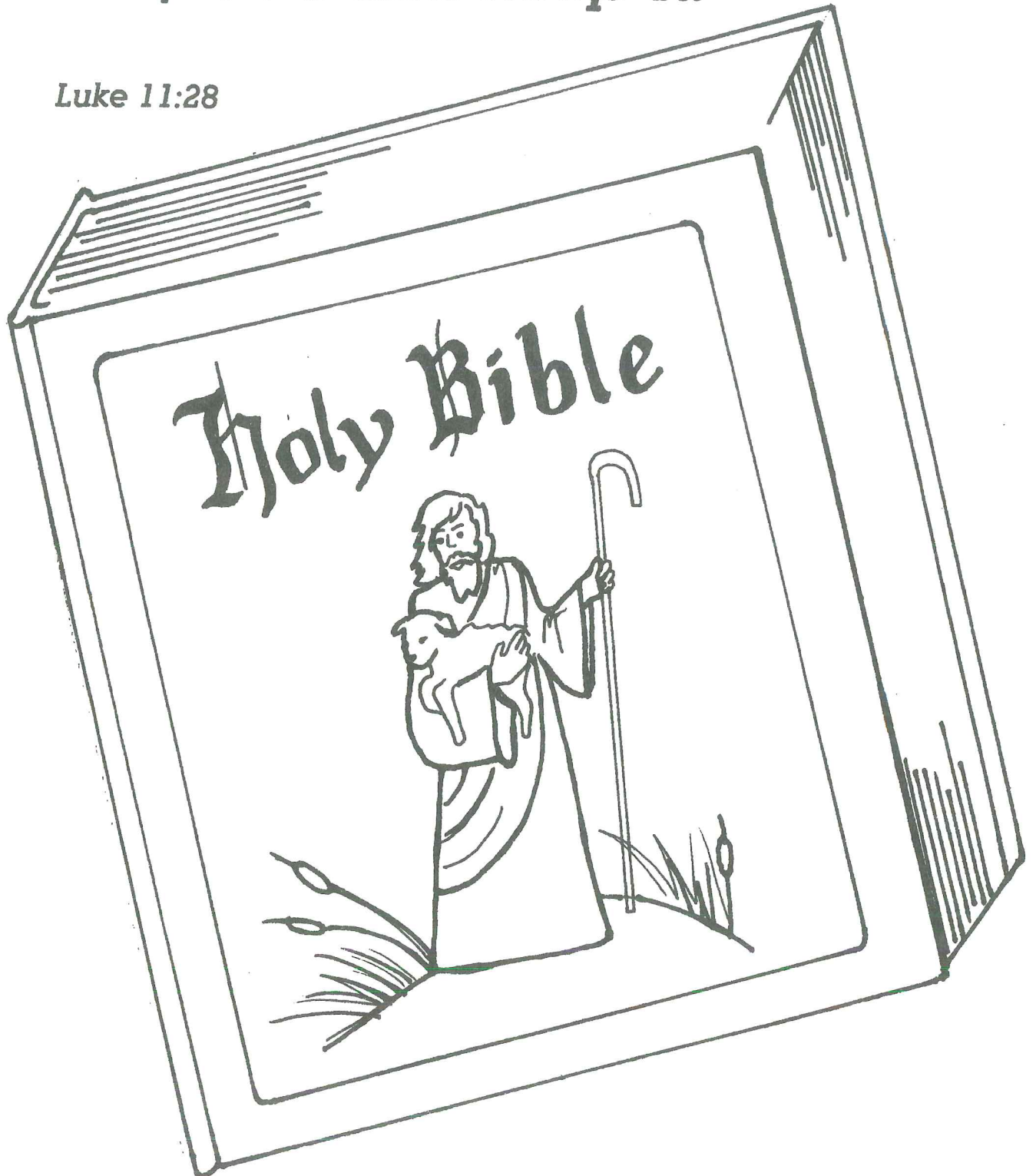
How are we to pick a church? God tells us to look for Jesus. We find Jesus in the Bible. God wants us to go to a church that teaches the way the Bible does.

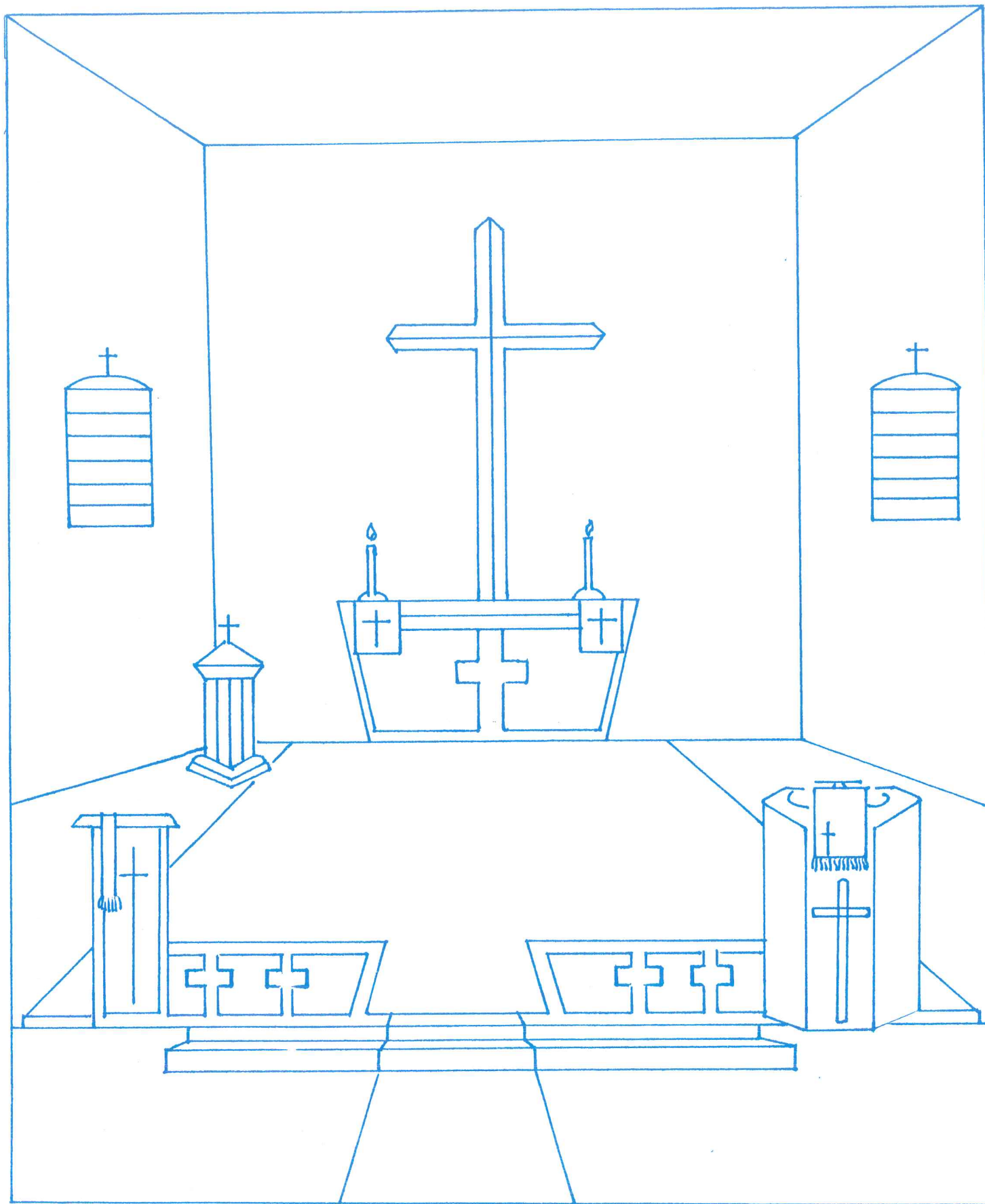
