One day Paul was trying to find some Christians to hurt. He was walking down a road. All at once there came a bright light. A






What does a missionary say to people? What was the missionary Paul to preach? What should you tell people? We can learn from our story about Philip.





Sometimes it is hard to be a missionary. People don't always want to listen to the Bible. But what people think or do should not stop us.

When it is hard to talk about Jesus,


God will help.

Text: Acts 10:9-16; 34-40; 42-43




esus had a disciple named Peter.

Text: Acts 16:9-15

God wants every Christian to be a missionary of Christ. Some Christians are pastors and preachers in the church. Some are teachers in Christian schools. Do you think you could be a pastor or teacher? More are needed. Pray to Jesus about it. But there are other ways of letting people know about Christ. One of the best ways is to show that we love Jesus by the way we live.


Remember how God made Paul a missionary? God wanted Paul to go into all the world and tell people about Jesus. Paul preached the Bible. A



woman named Lydia heard him. God made her a Christian. She was happy to hear about Jesus and how He died for her sins. Paul baptized her. She loved to hear God's Word. She was glad to go to church. Lydia sold purple dresses and shirts to people and gave the money to Jesus. She took care of God's missionaries. She fed them and gave them a


place to sleep. She showed her love for Jesus in many ways.


